THE HISTORY

Opening in 1927, Blatchford Field was Canada's first municipal air harbour. Blatchford Field Hangar was the first civic hangar on the site. It was also the first in Canada to train women as pilots.

During the Second World War, the Edmonton airfield helped move thousands of American bombers. Fighters and transport planes through Edmonton to Alaska and Russia, becoming a crucial part in the Allied war effort.
