THE HISTORY

This building is a reconstruction of the saloon building operated by Luke Kelly. The original was constructed in 1883 and functioned as a meeting place for local male inhabitants to discuss settlement issues, catch up on news, play cards, enjoy a game of billiards and engage in general camaraderie. It stood at Jasper Avenue and 98 Street, now occupied by Canada Place.
