Egge's Barn is the largest of Fort Edmonton Park's medium-sized venues with a capacity of 100 guests. This symmetrical venue features a main floor with newly renovated hardwood floors and gently lit with clear glass filament light bulbs, perfect for pre-dinner cocktail receptions and lively barn dances. The second-floor dining room offers rustic charm with its vaulted ceilings, exposed beams and wagon wheel chandeliers.

With four Dutch barn door windows that open to a picturesque view of Fort Edmonton Park, a fire pit and green space, Egge's Barn offers a great indoor/outdoor experience for truly memorable events.

THE HISTORY

Egge's Barn is a reproduction of a 1903 Pennsylvania Dutch-style barn that was part of a homestead developed by Newton and Cynthia Egge. The homestead was located halfway between Athabasca Landing and Edmonton and included a two-storey house, bunkhouse and barn. The Egge's began providing overnight accommodations and food to passing travellers journeying along the Athabasca Landing Trail.
