THE HISTORY

The original Hotel Selkirk was called the Windsor. Built in 1903, expanded and reopened in 1913 the Hotel Selkirk was a hot hangout spot, and many hotel guests were people of means and/or note. In 1962, the hotel suffered irreparable fire damage and was demolished to make way for a bank. Fort Edmonton's replica is based on the original blueprints, though the fact each room is larger and has an ensuite bathroom means there are fewer (27) rooms today.
